Case Study

New Oncology Outpatient Department at Hammersmith Hospital for Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust

This project involved the refurbishment of the Oncology department at Imperial college healthcare trust at Hammersmith Hospital. Although the building was unoccupied, this hospital is a busy environment so upmost care and consideration of the surrounding area was taken.

The newly refurbished Oncology unit was designed with patient experience as a top priority with floor finishes, wall finishes and the lighting to feel welcoming, inviting and to ease patient experience.

The department included a reception area with staff offices behind, several consulting rooms, Treatment rooms, scanning rooms, toilet facilites and some M&E located separately to the finished suite.

We have created a wonderful space which ties the entire project together with murals depicting calming plants, descriptors and colours seperating each consulting room to give patients the ability to find rooms easily. Floor vinyl was places strategically to 'slow' the flow of the building and to break up clean lines.

Complexities with the scope of works included:

- Live hospital Environment
- Programme
- M&E

How were these mitigated?

- Storm effectively communicated with the Architects & Trust to deliver the works within programme.
- Our Site management team was present for all structural elements on the project as well as overseeing the M&E installation process.
- Working around a live hospital is second nature to Storm as we consistently work in these projects.
